## Payment Options

## Business Regulations

### College Council

Fees, Charges and Conditions may be varied at the discretion of the College Council.

### Application Fee

A non-refundable Application Fee of \$110 (including GST) shall be lodged with each application for enrolment.

### Confirming Fee

Entry to Penrhos College is conditional upon the payment of a family-based non-refundable Confirming Fee. The fee is payable upon final acceptance of a student by the College. Subsequent enrolments under the Confirming Fee system apply only to immediate siblings. The Confirming Fee provides life membership of the Penrhos College Alumni and is passed on in full to the Penrhos College Foundation.

### Payment of Accounts

#### Tuition and Boarding Fees

Tuition Fees include all subject charges, normal sport, physical education, laboratory and year group outdoor education camps.

Boarding Fees include cleaning, laundry, routine nursing, approved recreational activities and transport. Please note uniform charges are not included.

Notebook Levy is an annual fee for the personal use of a notebook computer which includes warranty and general software costs. Damage and total loss of the notebook will incur an additional excess fee which will be charged to your account. Resource Fees for Junior School include all subject resources, stationery, incursions/excursions, and in-class use of iPads for Year 2 (\$100), iPads for Year 3 (\$200) and devices for Year 4 (\$200). Resource Fees for Senior School include some subject resources and incursions/excursions (in addition, items listed in the booklist are to be purchased by the Parent).

A late payment fee of \$150 (including GST) will be charged on accounts not paid within fourteen days of the due date unless previous arrangements have been made. Parents experiencing difficulty in paying fees should contact the Finance department before the due date to discuss alternative arrangements for payment.

Direct Debits returned unpaid or dishonoured will incur an Administration fee of \$15 (including GST) each.

Parents are responsible for the payment of avoidable breakages or damage to School property by their daughter(s).

Penrhos College reserves the right to refuse a student's commencement of a new Term if their account has not been paid in full.

### **Music and Speech & Drama Charges**

Music and Speech & Drama Charges are invoiced separately in Terms 1 and 3 for the semester in advance. Each semester delivers 16 lessons. Group lessons contain a maximum of 4 students per lesson.

### **Sundry Charges**

Sundry Charges are invoiced separately once each term, with payment due 14 days from invoice date.

Tickets for College events, for example, Year 12 Mother/ Daughter Dinner, School Production, Gala Night etc. will be available to purchase via the website.

### **Educational Tours**

Participation in any Penrhos College tour requires the Tuition Fee account to be up to date financially at the time of the Expression of Interest in the tour and to be kept up to date until the time of the tour. Payment schedules for Tours will be advised by the Tour Co-Coordinator at the time of your Expression of Interest and will be invoiced at least 14 days prior to payment date.

### **Payment Methods**

The College accepts the following payment methods:

- Cash
- Cheque (made payable to Penrhos College)
- International bank transfer (please contact Finance for bank transfer details)
- BPAY (the biller code and customer reference are stated on your invoice or statement)
- Credit card - in person, over the phone or via the Parent Portal (Mastercard, Visa or American Express) – all credit cards attract a surcharge of 0.9%

### **Notice of Withdrawal**

In the event of the withdrawal of a student at any stage during a term, the balance of Tuitions Fee, Resource Fee and Notebook Levy for the remainder of that term, plus any additional Music Charges, Speech & Drama Charges and Sundry Charges, shall become immediately due and payable. A full term's notice, in writing, must be given to the Principal, before the withdrawal of a student, otherwise an additional charge equal to one quarter of the annual tuition fee will apply (including GST).

In the event of the withdrawal of a boarding student at any stage during the year, the balance of Boarding Fees for the remainder of the year shall become immediately due and payable. A full Term's notice, in writing, of intention to withdraw a boarding student in the following year is required, otherwise a charge of one half of the following year's annual boarding fee is payable (including GST).

Music and Speech & Drama lessons for the following semester may be cancelled with formal written notice given to the Music Administration Coordinator or the Speech and Drama Teacher by the end of Week 6 of the previous term, otherwise the following semester charge will apply.

### **Insurance**

In addition to the required medical insurance organised by the College, you may wish to consider additional insurance with regard to personal property, liability and overseas travel cover. The College cannot accept responsibility for medical expenses arising from accident or illness, loss of or damage to personal effects and property or liability incurred by students for bodily injury or property damage.
